1953 Season Proving The Biggest In Many Years

Barring complete lack of cooperation on the part of the weather, and unlikely nation-wide economic collapse, the 1953 beach season here should end up by being among the best on record.

According to Chief of Police John Malek, the last two weekends saw more traffic moving along Ocean boulevard than anytime since he has been chief. Bumper-to-bumper lines of autos over Saturday and Sunday are a common sight and crowds numbering 50,000 to 70,000 are estimated to be on the beach front those days. Fortunately, the chief reports, there have been no serious accidents and collisions have been of a minor nature.

Ben Butler, beach Chamber of Commerce secretary said Monday, that the first four weeks of the summer period indicated that one of the best seasons in years could be expected if the weather kept on cooperating.

Several restaurants both on and off the boulevard say they are feeding more people than last year at this time. One reports business as being ahead of that when they closed their doors last September.

The beach post office, however, according to Ed Langley, in charge of the beach office, is not cancelling any appreciable increase in outgoing mail.

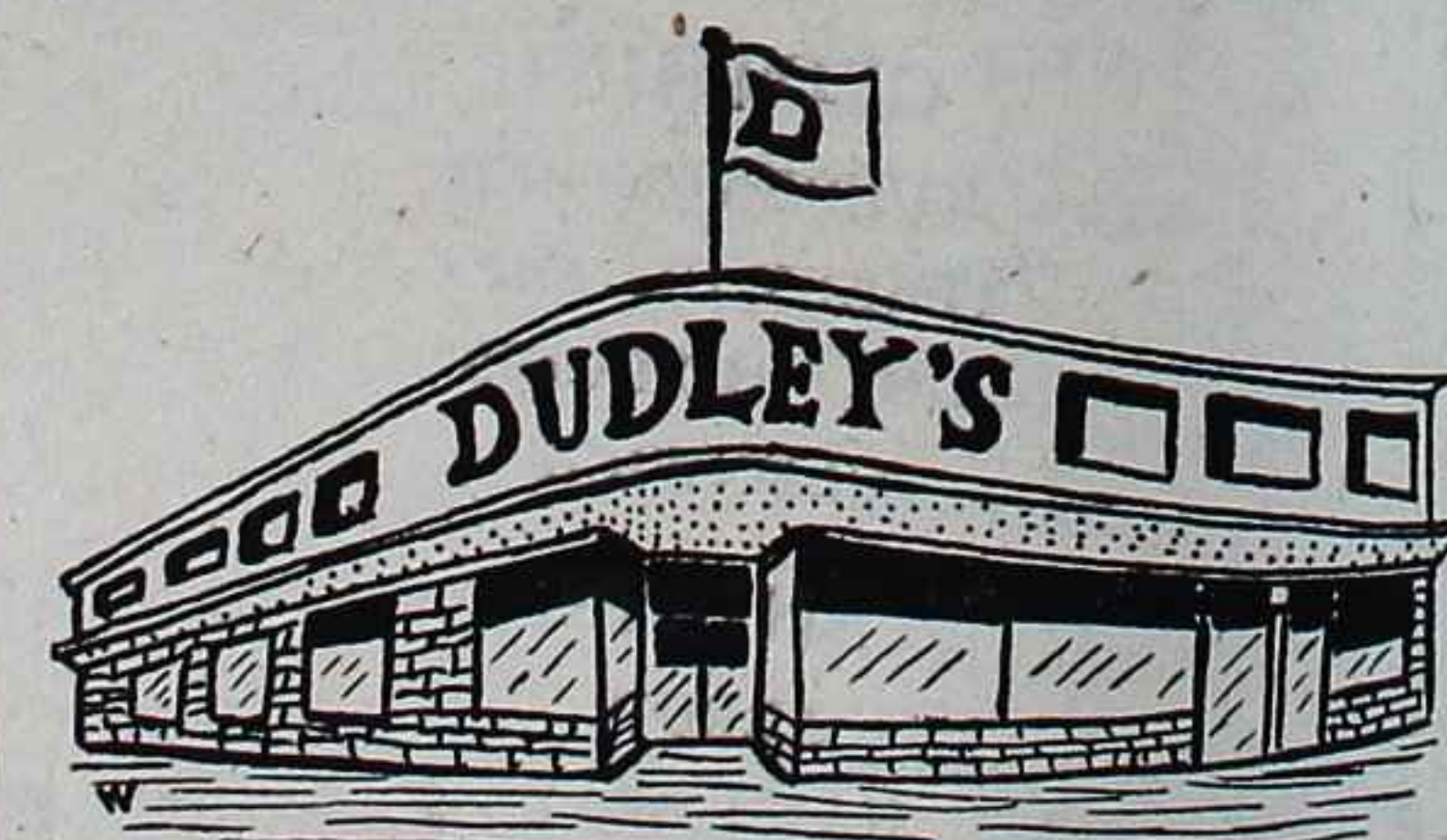

**Playhouse Drama**  
**Among The 'Best'**

The Hampton Summer Theatre dug its teeth into Paul Vincent Carroll's meaty drama, "Shadow and Substance" this week and came up with a solid performance that tops anything that has been done this year.

Very fine acting by Mary James and James Arenton added to excellent supporting performances played against Koester's most effective stage setting plus good execution of the difficult lighting plot by Roy Handwerk combined to produce an intense and thrilling evening of good theatre.

The strong motive of the play is the violent struggle between the Catholic canon who tyrannically clings to classical laws of the church in opposition to his curates and parishioners who want to seek a more humane and sentimental satisfaction of their humble religious needs. In despotically forcing his intellectual church on the sim-

ple Irish folk he loses contact with his people leaving him a lonely, misunderstood churchman.

James Arenton has played many fine roles but his portrayal of Canon Skerritt is by far his finest. The tragic role challenges the zenith of his ability. Arenton meets the challenge and gives Hampton theatre-goers a thrilling performance.

Equally fine is Mary James as Brigid. She plays the humble Irish housekeeper who knows and loves the canon. She understands his real inner warmth and provides him with the only bright spot in his lonely world. She gives sympathetic understanding in her delineation of Brigid's supernatural visitations from St. Brigid.

Outstanding in supporting roles was Louis Beachner, as the schoolmaster, O'Flingsley — Raymond Johnson as the newly certified teacher and Mary Fogarty, in her short but comic role of Rosey Violet.

Excellent support was also forthcoming from Gertrude Doolittle as Thomasine, Jack Evans as Father Corr, John Waggaman as Father Kirwan, Phoebe Mackay as Jerima Cooner and Ben Morse as Martin Mullahone.

"Shadow and Substance" is a play guaranteed to make you seethe in anger, cry in humility and laugh with vigor. It is strong drama. Its early success on the Broadway stage — including the Dramatic Critics Award — is self-evident and the Hampton Summer Theatre does full justice to lives created by Paul Vincent Carroll.
