The 20 guards would be hired by the state lifeguard training officer and trained by a head lifeguard under the supervision of the training officer. The

head guard's duties would consist of constantly patrolling the entire length of beach and drilling the guards every day. It was recommended that the head guard be provided with a jeep with over-size balloon tires and ambulance type body. Emergency equipment such as resuscitators, stretchers and first aid equipment should be kept in the jeep, which should also be equipped with a two-

frequency, the report specified. The report strongly recommended that state beach rules and regulations be put into effect for the entire beach and that lifeguards be kept in constant practice of their life saving techniques. It was also suggested that the pay of lifeguards should be up-graded to that of the state system.


