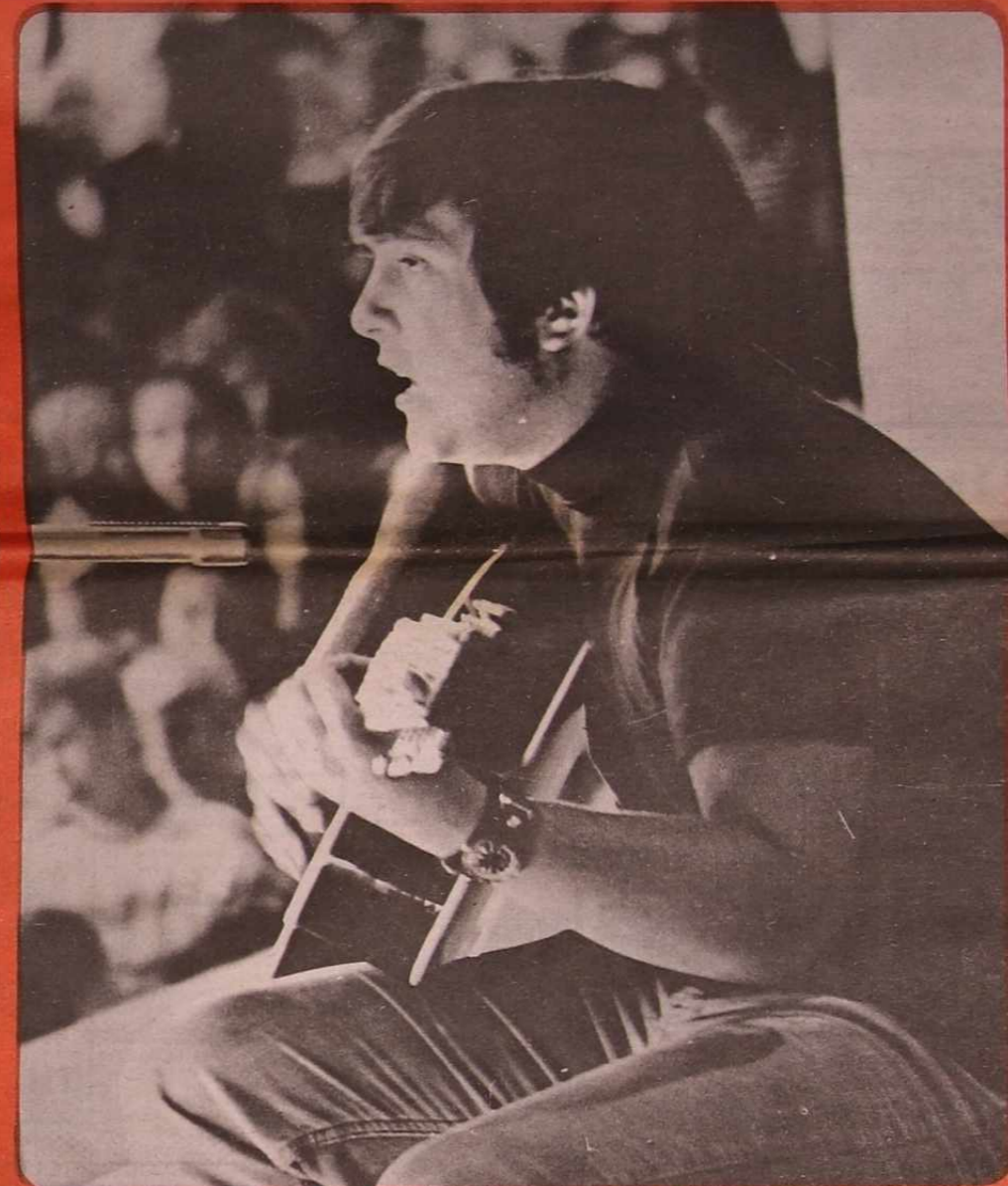

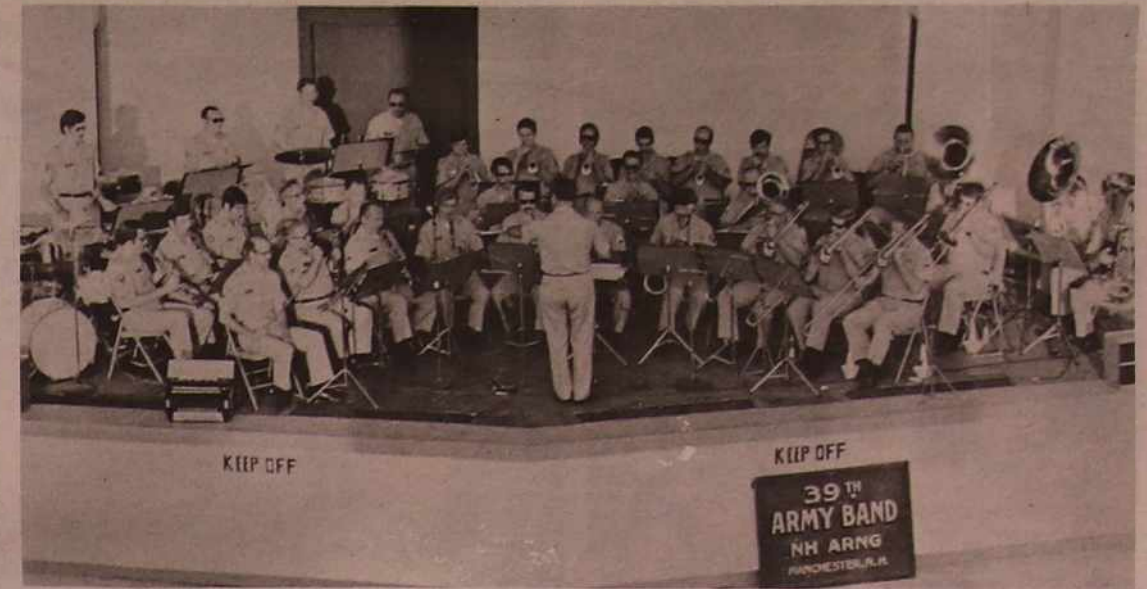

ORDINANCES

New as well as old ordinances are now in effect at Hampton Beach. These are posted at the Hampton Beach Chamber of Commerce and many other locations throughout the beach.

It is recommended that visitors become acquainted with these ordinances, to avoid possibility of violations, thus making your stay at Hampton a better vacation.

Hampton Beach is State owned and controlled.

The following have been adopted in the interest of safety at all New Hampshire State Park Beaches:

- Swimming shall be restricted to the areas designated as the swimming beach.
- Inflatables shall not be permitted in the water.
- Empty bottles shall not be permitted on the beach or in the water.
- Fires shall not be permitted.
- Alcoholic beverages are prohibited in public.
- Dogs and other pets shall not be permitted in the water or on the beach.
- Changing of clothes in car is prohibited.
- All persons shall obey any reasonable request by authorized park attendants or life-guards.
- Lifeguards and the Chamber of Commerce shall not assume parental responsibilities for children left unattended by their parents or guardian.

Cathy's Corner

My family's been a fishing family way back past good old Uncle Ebenezer who was my great grandfather's great grandfather's uncle. Un-

cle Ebenezer was quite a fellow and stories about the old guy are limited only by my father's imagination. It seems Old Eb lost his life at sea and his spirit has watched over each generation of his fishing family ever since. Whenever we have fantastic fishing or find something interesting such as a 200 year old anchor it's always thanks to good old Uncle Ebenezer. Uncle Eb also taught the family how to salt codfish and we continue today to practice this ancient method of preserving fish. The number one ingredient is naturally a codfish and the best are from 10 to 30 pounds. The cod fish is split along the backbone and then salted down for one or two days. Uncle Ebenezer probably used a barrel for the salting but now in modern times we use the bath tub. There's nothing like looking forward to a long shower after a hot day at the beach and then returning home to find a salted cod in the tub. I've thrown a lot of codfish out of that tub too! Next the fish spends at least three days in the hot dry sun, then back in the house to sweat a few days and then back to the sun. After about two weeks the fish are completely cured and are now called dunfish (they're done alright). These fish stay edible for quite some time but of course there's those who'll say that a salt cod will never be edible. What was good enough for Eb is good enough for us. . . good enough for my father anyway.

and 35 pound blue hake were caught. Mrs. Franconer of Bondsville Mass. got a 16 pound codfish. She comes fishing each weekend and is a very good fisherman (as most females are!) Lots of cod and cusk were caught this week and 8 Haddock on one trip and just about everyone caught at least one fish and most people caught more the day I went out. There's no guarantee that you'll hook into one but the chances are pretty good.

Frank Dennis, a faithful customer from Schenectady, N.H. has caught a good amount of fish this vacation. Frank, who's been fishing here at the Smith and Gilmore Fishing Pier for over 20 years now brings his grandchild with him instead of his children as he did in years past. 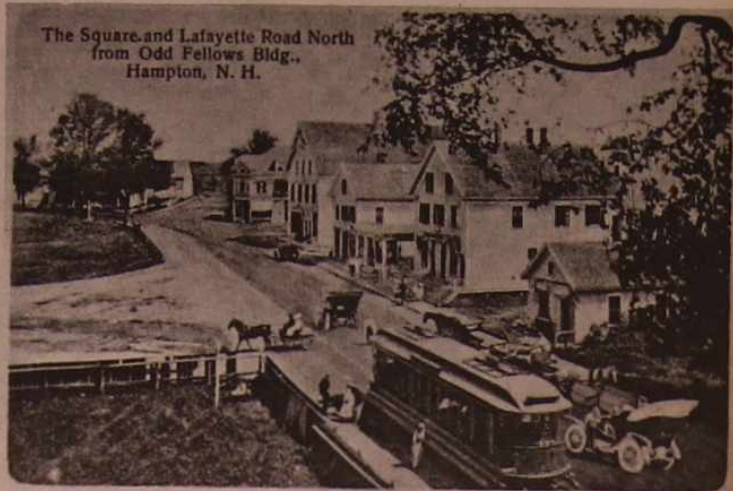

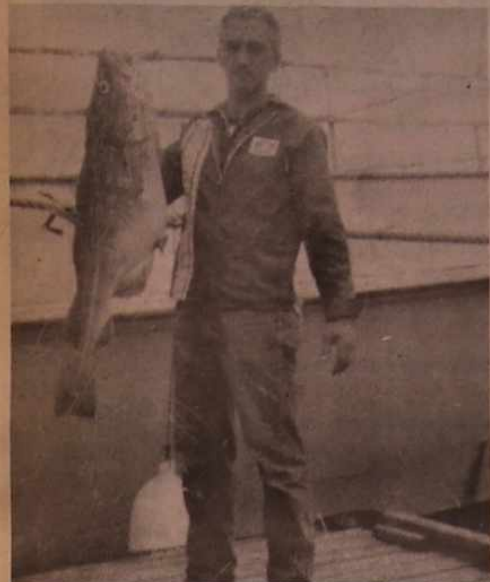

The sport clam diggers braved the green head flies and other insects to fill their baskets but others gave up.

Lobster fishermen are only pulling their traps every two or three days so their catch will build up to a worth while trip.

The Hampton Marshes - These "salt" marshes today are the only natural areas to be kept just as our forefathers saw them. Today they serve as wild life preserves and yesterday they served as hay fields for our farming community. Sites of the old hay stacks can still be seen at low tide.

Tuck Memorial Museum - The Hampton Historical Society's museum is located on the original Meeting House Green, on Park Avenue, and contains antiques, silver, glass, china, quilts, costumes, documents, post cards, photographs, implements, and the like which pertain to an earlier Hampton. It is open to the public every afternoon during July and August from 1 to 4 p.m. and the admission is FREE.

Norsemen's Rock - located off Thorvald Avenue in Surfside Park, is thought to be the final resting place of Lief Erikson's brother who was killed by Indians in 1008 A.D. This story can be found both in local Indian legend and Viking Mythology. Markings, thought to be of Viking origin, can be seen on the Rock.

Places of Interest

Founder's Park - located off Park Avenue and Landing Road, opposite the Tuck Museum, is dedicated to Rev. Stephen Bachler and those founding families of Hampton of 1638. Stones have been placed on the Meeting House Green memorial Park by the various "daughter" towns and bearing their names as well as many family stones with the names of the early settlers. It is believed that this Park is unique in the United States. The Park was dedicated on October 14, 1925, "Founder's Day."

Meeting House Green - located on Park Avenue, adjacent to the Tuck Museum, where the first settlers of Hampton built their first Meeting House in 1638. Here the first homes appeared, and around the Green, early Hampton grew and prospered. Today the Green contains the buildings of the Hampton Historical Society, the Tuck House, the Tuck Memorial Museum and the One - room District School House. Also various historical markers of Hampton's past can be viewed on the Green.

The Landing - On the 14th of October 1638, Rev. Stephen Bachler and his small band of pioneers, landed her and proceeded to the Meeting House Green on what is now Landing Road. Known as "Nudd's Landing," this Marsh land area was a scene of the first brick yard, boat building site, and salt works. It is located at the end of Landing Road next to the Hampton Boat Club.

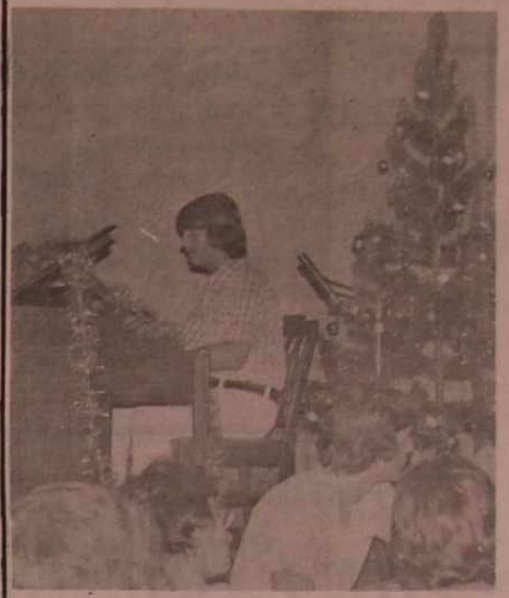
