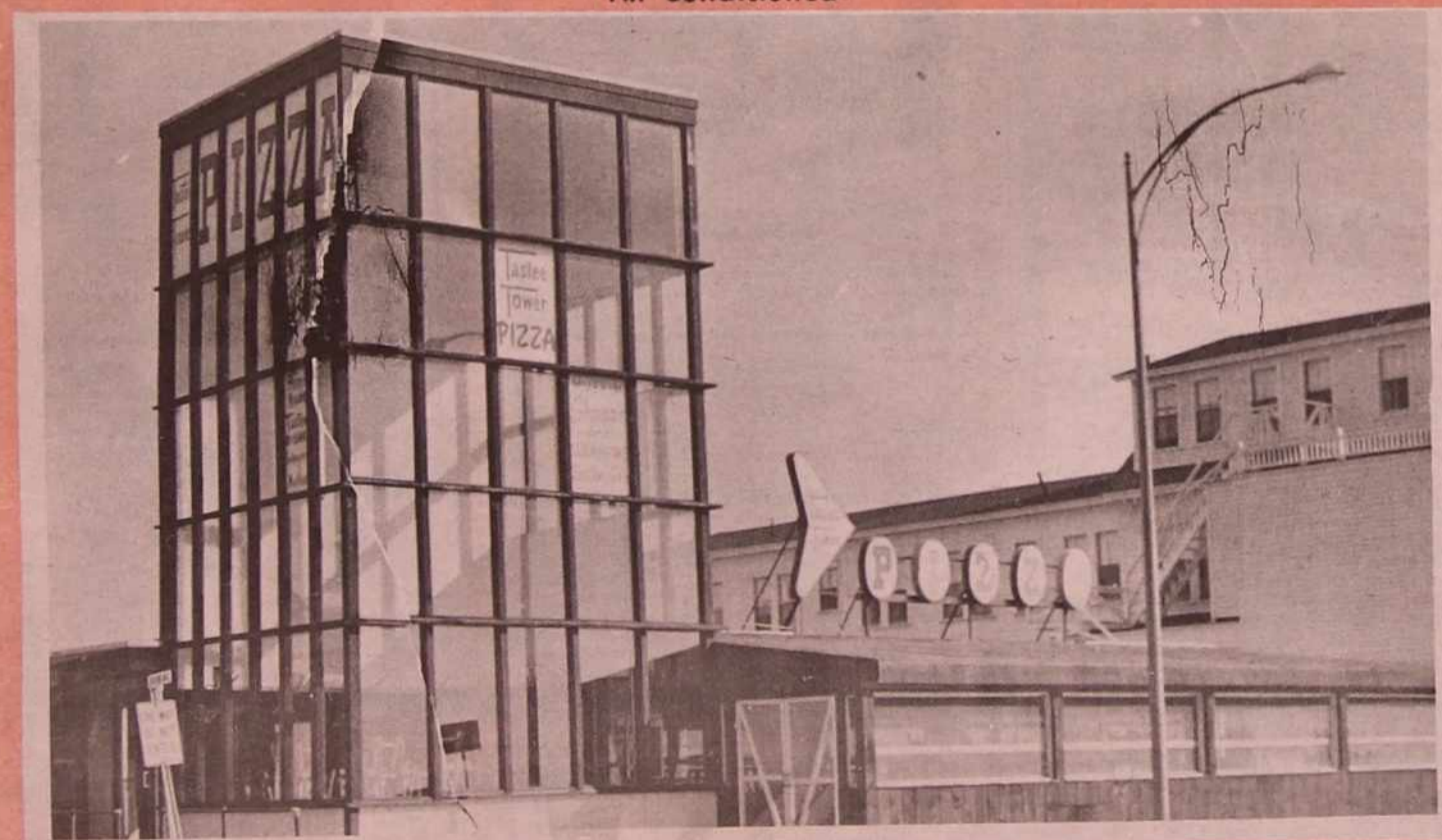

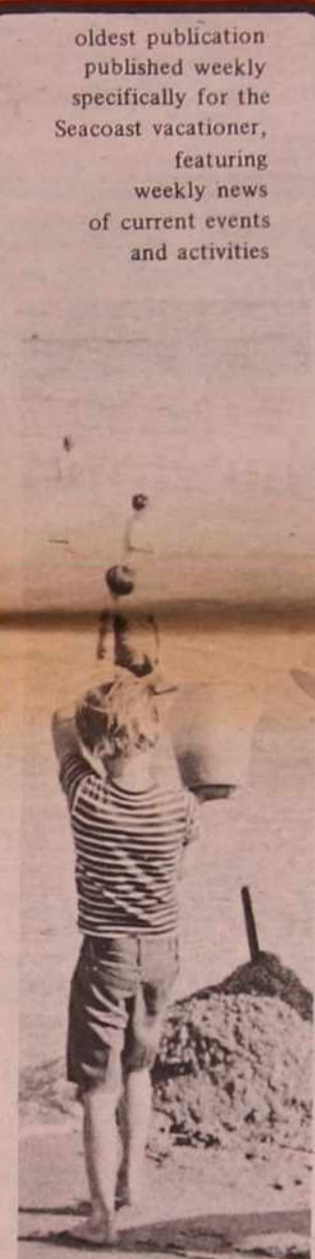

**Men With Big Hearts  
Handicapped Youngsters  
Treated To Annual  
Hampton Beach Outing**

HAMPTON BEACH - An outing for the blind and physically handicapped of Camp Allen, Bedford, N.H. was held Sunday, August 18th at the State Park in Hampton.

For the tenth consecutive year the Teamster Employees of Auclair Transportation Co. Inc. of Manchester, N.H. their wives and friends pooled their energy and resources and came up with a successful effort.

Co-chairmen at the event again this year were Ken Booth and Jim Patenaude.

Approximately one hundred children, counselors and staff members boarded three buses Sunday morning for the song-filled ride to the beach. An advance group of workers had set up tables and prepared a lunch of sandwiches and milk by the time the happy campers arrived.

After a rest period the children were taken to the beach by the counselors and truck drivers, one of whom remarked that he would never transport a more valuable cargo.

There were mixed feelings among the campers as they approached water's edge. Some were eager to feel the salt water while others hesitated but were finally coaxed into the cool surf.

While the youngsters were enjoying the ocean, musical instruments, amplifiers, and hundreds of feet of extension cord were being assembled by a group of musicians recruited by an Auclair Employee, Bob Bergeron, who is a well known drummer in the Manchester, N.H. area.

The band, complete with an attractive vocalist, swung into action as the campers were being brought back to the picnic area from their afternoon on the beach. The campers displayed their knowledge of contemporary music by singing along with the band, while other visitors to the State Park gathered round the area to enjoy the free concert.

Meanwhile, back at the grill the chefs, Roland and Armand Gauthier and their assistants were preparing the traditional ingredients for a meal at any outing - hot dogs and hamburgers.

The salt water and singing surely whetted the appetites of the campers for what seemed like an endless number of hamburger patties and hot dogs were grilled, surrounded by rolls, seasoned and consumed in an amazingly short time.

The weatherman cooperated again as he has done in all but one of the ten years. Partly cloudy skies with temperatures in the 80's guaranteed a successful day weather-wise.

After a thorough clean up of the area, everyone piled into the buses for the return trip to the camp. A surprise treat for all was a stop at a drive-in restaurant for ice cream half way home.

After arriving at Camp Allen just before sundown, a final treat was in store for the weary but happy campers. Thick slices of watermelon were attacked by the children and reduced to seeds and rind.

A perfect ending to a perfect day was insured when the appreciative campers told the truckers that Auclair Transportation hires the nicest people in the world.

**Al Gauron 40 Years At Hampton Beach**

After nearly 40 yrs as a Hampton Beach resident and businessman, Al Gauron has viewed the growth of the Seacoast area for many years. Mr. Gauron was born on Hampton Beach and grew up in the area. In 1935 Al started his deep sea fishing business dur-

ing the summer months. The summers were devoted to the tourist trade while winters were spent, as they still are, repairing and improving his business. For many years he fished commercially during the off-season months.

Al remembers when electric cars and the absence of year round residents dominated the seacoast area. But because of new roads and the attractiveness of the area Gauron has seen the seacoast develop into what it is today.

Al Gauron's deep sea fishing parties have progressed as well. Today he and his four sons run three party boats, a restaurant and a motel.

Gauron doesn't want to see the proposed nuclear power plant placed in the seacoast area. Gauron realizes the need for new power sources but the seacoast area would gain nothing from it he says. Gauron says that the power plant is psychologically and ecologically unsound. The radiation in

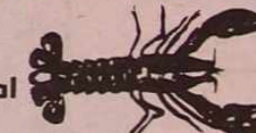

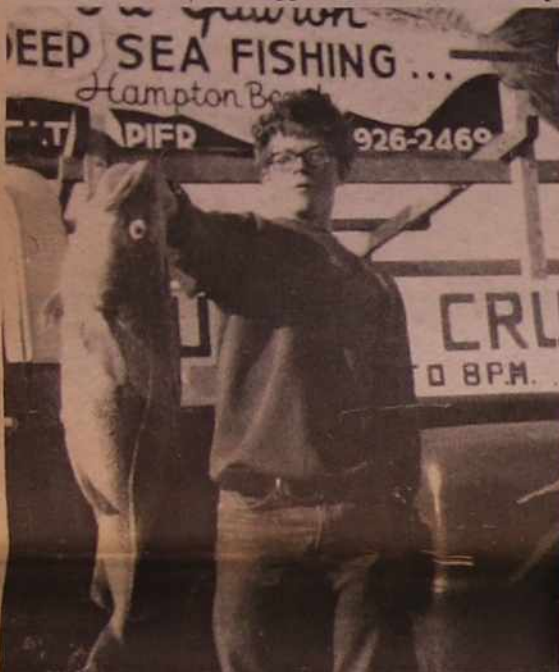

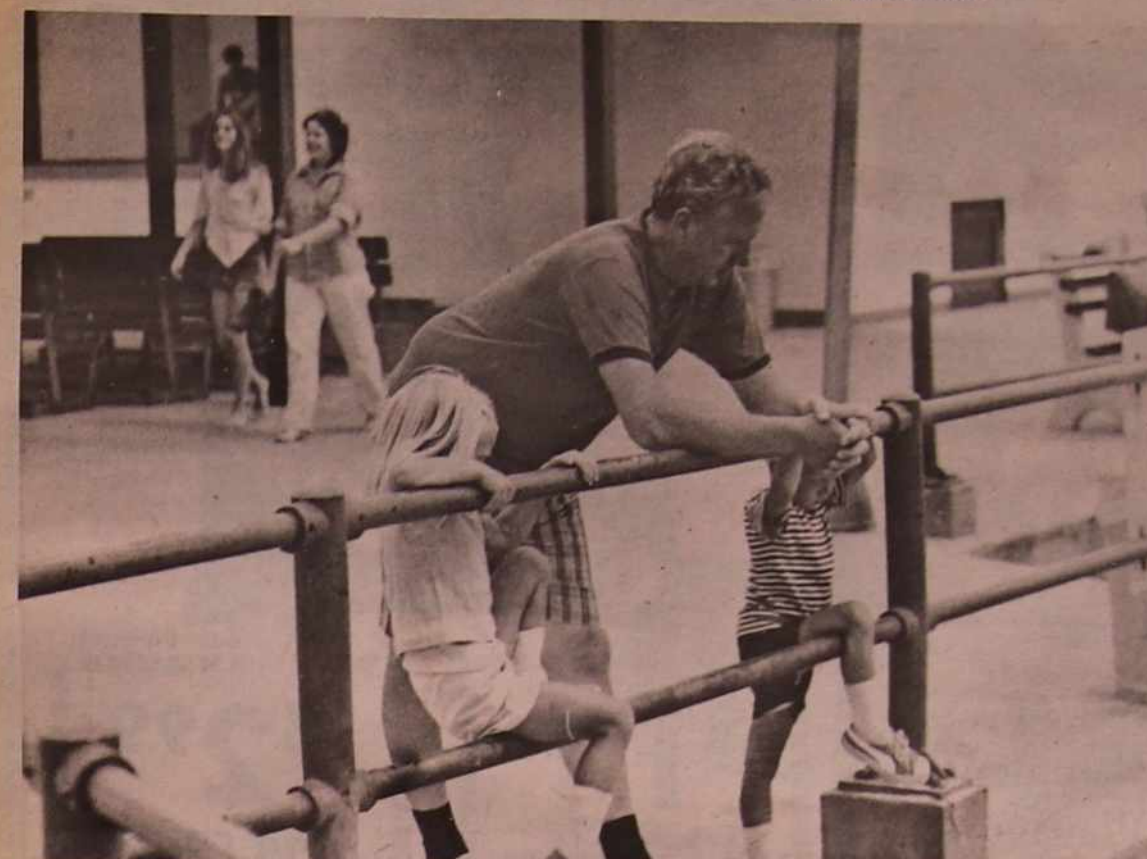

**Beach Amusements Provide Fun For All Ages**  
HAMPTON BEACH - Names like "Attack" and "Periscope", printed in sizes of menacing proportion are the natural extension of the simple shooting gallery. As jet planes and aircraft carriers have replaced the everyday western outlaw as targets, torpedos and 50 millimeter artillery have replaced the traditional bolt action rifle as weapons.  
Thrill seekers of all ages come, coin in hand, to shoot down streaking jet planes, sink convoys or smite the most ferocious of prehistoric animals. Others less interested in marksmanship, turn to the pinball machines which line both walls of a long corridor. Here solace can be found amidst sparking lights and clattering digit counters.  
Not surprisingly, there seems to be a certain degree of "professionalism" which must be maintained among a group of regulars who most often frequent the halls.

the waters along the seacoast is potentially dangerous to the already faltering commercial fishing business. Gauron says that just one oil spill could destroy the tourist season at Hampton Beach for an entire year.

Mr. Gauron is also fighting for the proposed 200 mile fishing limit. He says that the Russian, East German and Japanese boats that sit just 18 miles from our shores are destroying the fishing industry in this area. Gauron says that he owes a lot to the public for making his business a success for the past 40 yrs. It is the public who has supported the seacoast area for years and it is the public who should be able to come back to Hampton Beach without fear of oil refineries or power plants.

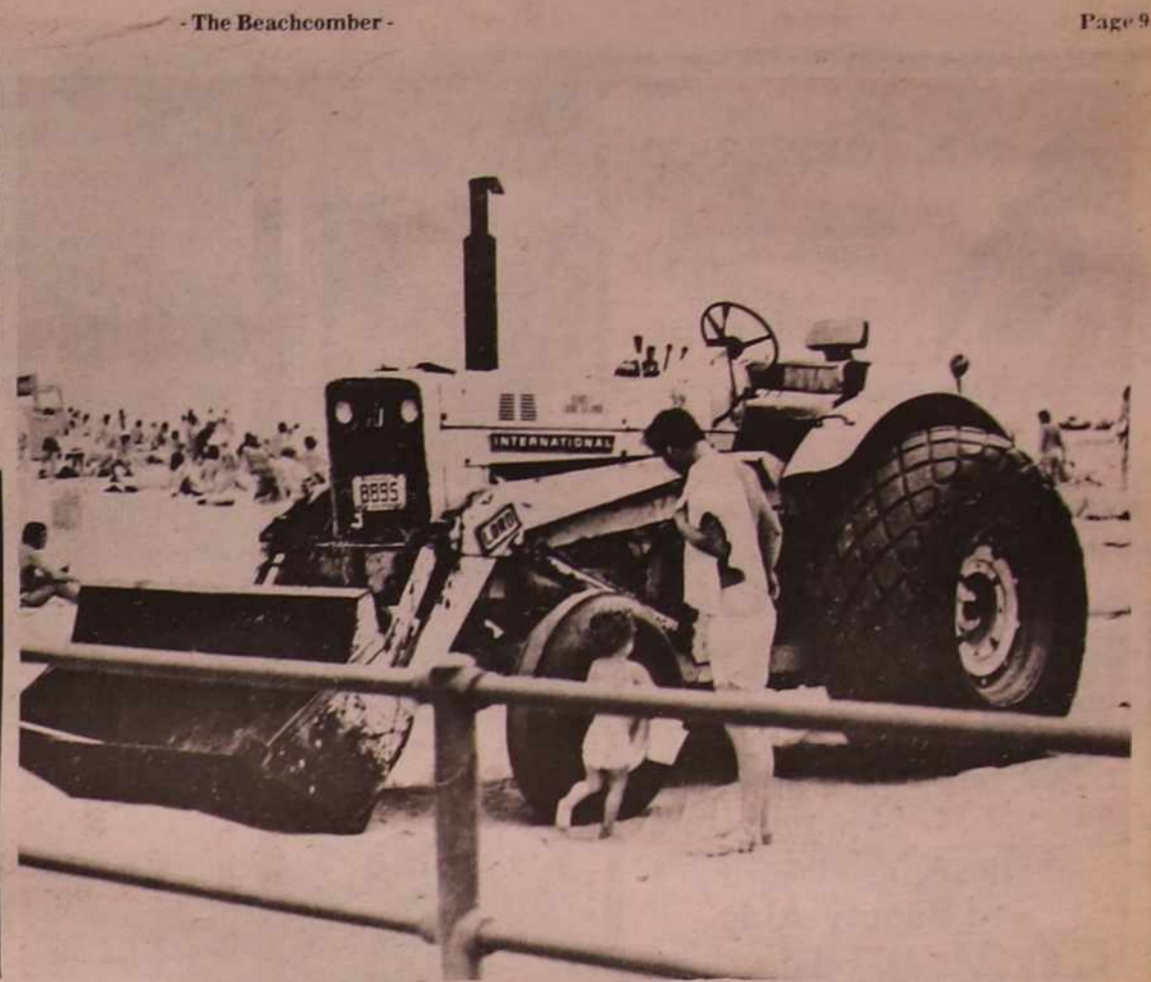

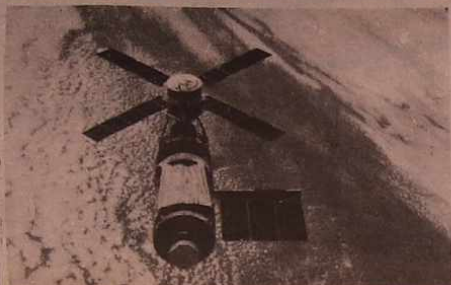

HAMPTON BEACH - There's a bicycle boom going on all over North America and the Seacoast region is no exception.

From teenagers on ten-speeds to retired people on folding bikes and adult tricycles, people of all ages and descriptions can be seen pedaling along the beach area.

"Bicycles are a necessity for the beach," Russ Preston, owner of U-ot-to-bike on Hampton Beach, said.

"People can see more of the seacoast on bikes than they can walking because they can cover more area, and they can see more than they can in a car because they're not going so fast," he said.

Cyclists can start and stop when they want to, there's no problem with parking, they can go almost everywhere, bikes use no gas and their riders get plenty of sun and fresh air. These are a few of the reasons cited by Preston for the popularity of bikes.

Preston said there had been a tremendous increase in the number of bicycles on the beach every year until this year, but he blamed the tapering off to the fact that fewer people are on the beach this year.

"Cycling is a great way to get exercise and have fun at the same time," Preston said.

A similar view is held by Gus Van Cauwenberg, owner of Gus' International Cycle Shop in North Hampton and a bicycle racing champion himself.

"People are getting smart," he said. "They know they do too much sitting behind the wheel and in front of the TV screen."

"Three years ago I was the only one on the beach riding a bicycle, but every day as the season went on I saw more and more people riding bikes. I knew then that cycling was going to be big," he said.

He said the novice cyclist may find that too many years of sedentary living have left him out of shape huffing and puffing after a short ride, but that in a short time he'll be climbing hills with ease, particularly on a ten-speed racer.

"People should get more exercise," he said, "not necessarily only on bicycles but in any way they can for the sake of their muscles, heart, lungs...you name it."

"You can never do any harm by exercising."
